Works notification | 24 October 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The partitions in the girls' toilets in Building A will be replaced at Springwood High School.

The toilet partitions in this building are listed on the school's asbestos register as containing bonded asbestos. A chemical sealant has encapsulated the partition surface, allowing the toilets to be operational until they can be replaced.

On Saturday 9 November the partitions will be removed. The new partitions will be installed between Monday 11 November and Wednesday 13 November 2024 between the hours of 7am and 4pm. Students will be advised to use existing alternative toilets during this period.

During the works, temporary fencing will make the toilets inaccessible to students and staff.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done.

All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

Once work is completed, a clearance certificate will be issued by an independent hygienist before the toilets are reopened for use.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
