Dear staff, parents and carers,

School holidays are the ideal time to undertake maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning.

Planned work over the upcoming holidays

We will be working at Fairvale High School during the autumn holidays.

This period may include from the end of the school day on Thursday 2 April 2026 up to the first day of Term 2 Wednesday 22 April 2026.

We will be converting the careers room, an office, boys toilet and 3 storerooms on the bottom floor of Building E into boys and girls toilets and a maintenance room.

The internal walls have been removed and we have begun framing the new walls. During the autumn holidays we will begin the installation of new plumbing and water services as well as toilet amenities.

Installation work will continue during Term 2 2026 and is expected to be finished at the start of May 2026.

Building E remains accessible to students and staff while this work takes place. The rooms being converted have not been in active use by the school.

A small area near the covered outdoor learning area (COLA) will be fenced off for contractor vehicles if required.

Managing construction

Construction vehicles and equipment will be used during this work which may cause periods of noise.

Work hours are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.

Contractors will access the school grounds through the Tripoli Road entrance.
