Dear staff, parents/carers,

We will be replacing the vinyl tiles in the laundry room in the food tech and art building (Building D) at Kingswood High School on Saturday 8 June and Sunday 9 June 2024.

During this work, we will be removing bonded asbestos-containing material from underneath the tiles identified on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that if bonded asbestos is mixed with cement or other hard bonding materials, and in good condition, it is likely to be low-risk.

Access to the room is restricted and will remain out of bounds to both students and staff until the work is completed.

All work will be done outside of school hours, in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures are in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The laundry room will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before the room is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
