Works notification | 14 August 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are refurbishing the staff toilets and removing the adjoining cement sunshade in Building F at James Busby High School. As part of this work asbestos containing material within the vinyl tiles of the staff bathroom, and within cement sunshade will need to be removed.

The staff bathroom and sunshade are being used safely at present as the material is undisturbed and out of reach to students and staff.

The areas will be cordoned off before the work starts, and safety measures and monitoring put in place.

Work to remove the vinyl tiles and the sunshade will take place on Saturday 26 August 2023.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The areas will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the areas are reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
