## James Busby High School Works notification | 8 May 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

In collaboration with the Australian Government's Schools Upgrade Fund, we are excited to announce that we will be building a new Centre for Learning and Innovation at James Busby High School.

Work has started this week with site establishment and surveying. We have installed fences around the work site behind the library and along a vehicle accessway. Work vehicles will be entering through a designated entrance on Brolga Crescent and accessing the work site through the school site by travelling along the western fence and north boundary fence of the school.







## What to expect

During the works, there may be some construction noise as there will be heavy machinery, concrete trucks, and steel delivery vehicles accessing the school. As such, some noise and disruption can be expected throughout the construction period.

During this time there will be an increase in truck and contractor vehicle movements in nearby streets. All construction vehicles will access the construction site via the designated entrance on Brolga Crescent.

There will be no changes to student drop off zones and staff car parking at the school will not be affected.

Contractors will have noise and dust mitigation measures in place and will monitor levels throughout the construction period. Noisy works will be conducted outside of school hours as much as possible to minimise any disruption to the school and surrounding community.

Construction is expected to be completed in September 2025.

## **Work hours**

Construction works will take place **Monday to Friday between 7 am and 6 pm, and Saturday between 8 am and 1pm with no work permitted on Sundays or public holidays**.
