

# Narromine High School

## Works notification | 12 December 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are upgrading the women's staff amenities in Building A at Narromine High School, and discovered materials containing bonded asbestos during the refurbishment on Monday 1 December 2025.

The area where the material was found was already fenced off within the construction site. Construction was immediately stopped when the material was found and the area was locked and remains inaccessible to staff.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

This location is not listed in the school's asbestos management plan.

The asbestos will be removed on Monday 15 December 2025 outside of school hours.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The area will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before work resumes.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
