Works notification | 11 December 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are repairing several windows that were damaged on 3 December 2023 in Buildings C and E at Glendale Technology High School. Following the damage, the impacted rooms were cordoned off between 3 and 4 December and an accredited contactor attended the site to secure the areas. After the windows were secured, the rooms were reopened for use.

Work to repair the windows will involve working with known and suspected asbestos containing material in the window frames.

Work to remove the material and repair the windows will take place in January during the Summer school holiday period. The rooms continue to be used for the remainder of the term as this material is undisturbed and in good condition.

The areas will be cordoned off just before the work starts, with additional safety measures and air monitoring in place.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before the work starts.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The buildings will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before it is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
