Works notification | 11 May 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

On Wednesday 6 May 2026, a wall panel was mistakenly removed from the staff bathroom in Building A at Glendale Technology High School. This area is known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

As a precaution, the area was immediately isolated to restrict access to students, staff and school visitors, and an independent hygienist was engaged to conduct air monitoring and provide advice.

All air monitoring to date across the site has returned results below the minimum detectable limit, which means it is consistent with acceptable levels in ambient air (i.e. <0.01 fibres/mL) as per SafeWork NSW guidelines. These results show that there is not a detectable level of asbestos fibres in the air in this area.

Work to replace the panel and seal any gaps took place on Thursday 7 May 2026. The hygienist returned to inspect the site and provided clearance for normal activities from Friday 8 May 2026.

All work was done in accordance with work, health and safety laws. All work was completed by experienced contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
