Works notification | 1 June 2026

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

We would like to provide you with an update on our response to the damage caused by the fire on Monday 20 April 2026 at Glendale Technology High School.

Demountable buildings

As indicated in our works notification from [6 May 2026](#), 15 demountable buildings have been installed on the south-eastern side of the school grounds and are now being used by the school community.

Privacy screening has been procured and will be installed on the demountable windows by mid-July 2026.

Demountable buildings provide schools with versatile spaces ensuring our schools can adapt quickly after disasters and continue delivering quality education without disruption.

In times of crisis these portable and refurbished buildings offer safe, secure, well-insulated, temperature controlled, environmentally friendly, spacious, and bright spaces while permanent repairs are underway.

Buildings E and G

Ground floor spaces in Building G have been inspected, cleaned, cleared and reopened for the school to use as normal.

Students have returned from the temporary arrangement with the local TAFE back into the school's classrooms in Building G and the demountable classrooms now on site. The temporary classrooms set up in the Multi-Purpose Centre (MPC) are no longer needed, and work has begun to restore the MPC to its original condition.

The first floors of buildings E and G are undergoing further testing by the independent hygienist and will remain isolated from students and staff to determine the extent of any repairs required. These investigations relate to potential smoke and soot contamination from Building F and will inform what work needs to be done before the upper-level areas of these buildings are reopened.

The plan for the future of Building F is still being developed. We will keep the school community updated once more information becomes available.

Fencing work

We are replacing a section of damaged fence along the shared south-eastern boundary fence between Glendale Technology High School and at Oakland Street.

Work to replace the fence will take place between Monday 22 and Monday 29 June 2026 depending on weather and other site conditions.



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Sections of the current fence will be replaced with 90 metres of 2.1 metre high Colorbond panels, matched with the existing height and fence colour “basalt”.

By replacing fencing, we will provide greater safety and security for our students, staff and the wider community.

Work hours will be from 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturday. No work will be done on Sundays or public holidays.
