Dear staff, parents, and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and local community remain our highest priorities.

We would like to provide you with an update on our response to the damage caused by a fire on Monday 20 April 2026 at Glendale Technology High School.

Asbestos removal work in Building F

Following on from our [1 June 2026 notification](#), we will be removing asbestos containing material (ACM) from a locked electrical switchboard room in Building F.

Building F has remained isolated and secured with air monitoring in place. Material in parts of this building are known to have ACM as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

We will be removing the ACM on Thursday 25 June 2026 to prepare for upcoming electrical works. Removal will be completed outside of school hours under the supervision of an independent hygienist with safety measures and air monitoring in place.

As the switchboard room contains known friable ACM, the area will receive clearance following the removal so that work in this building can continue. Friable ACM can be crumbled, pulverised or reduced to a powder by hand pressure.

Air monitoring to date across the site has returned results below the minimum detectable limit, which means it is consistent with acceptable levels in ambient air (i.e. <0.01 fibres/mL) as per SafeWork NSW guidelines. These results show that there is not a detectable level of asbestos fibres in the air in this area.

Air monitoring will remain in place following completion of these works.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's School Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.
