Dear staff, parents and carers,

During a recent routine inspection, rust was identified in the roof panels in Building H at Glendale Technology High School.

The material in the roof panels is known to contain bonded asbestos. NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

Work to repair and secure the roof panels are planned to take place on Saturday 7 December 2024.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours. All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

Following the work the building will be inspected by the independent hygienist and clearance will be provided.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
