

Mulwaree High School

Works notification | 6 May 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During the Autumn School Holidays we began roof replacement work on the library at Mulwaree High School.

While undertaking this work the contractor identified bonded asbestos in the box gutter on both sides of the building.

Work was stopped, the gutters were encapsulated with plastic and the building was cordoned off with temporary fencing.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

The asbestos in the gutter was removed and the area was inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it was fully remediated with a clearance certificate issued before work continued.

The roof replacement work will continue during Term 2 and is scheduled to be complete on 30 May 2025.

All asbestos removal work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures were in place while work was being done. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
