

Casula High School

Works notification | 8 March 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Maintenance works are underway to replace the vinyl floor tiles at Casula High School and will involve working with asbestos containing material under the carpet in two classrooms and one movement area in Building A; two classrooms in Building E and three classrooms in Building H.

Work to remove the material is underway and is expected to be complete by 9 March 2023. All asbestos containing material will be removed after school hours and in accordance with the advice of the independent hygienist.

The areas have been cordoned off in sections for the work to begin, and safety measures and monitoring put in place. It will remain out of bounds to students and staff until the removal work is finished.

Work is being done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work is being completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The area will be inspected to ensure it has been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is open to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
