Works notification | 27 February 2024

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

During a recent maintenance inspection at Davidson High Public School, asbestos containing materials were discovered in 2 general learning rooms in Building E. The rooms were immediately locked, and access was restricted.

Safety measures were put in place and the area remained out of bounds to students and staff until the asbestos removal work was completed.

Work took place on Thursday 15 February (after hours).

Work was done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

An independent hygienist inspected the area, confirmed it had been fully remediated, and issued a clearance certificate.

The rooms were reopened and made available for use on Monday 19 February.
