

Davidson High School

Works notification | July 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are upgrading the electrical infrastructure at Davidson High School.

What we are doing

In July 2026, minor excavation work started on surrounding streets including Pound Avenue and Mimosa Street. New electrical cables will be run along the school driveway from Pound Avenue.

We expect to complete this stage in early August 2026.

In September 2026, we will start wiring cables to a new electrical substation installed along the school's driveway.

On Saturday 17 October 2026, a contractor will install a new power pole on Pound Avenue, and complete associated high and low voltage works.

The Outside of School Hours (OOSH) care service continues to operate as normal during this work.

Managing construction impacts

The safety of the school, visitors and the local community is our highest priority. We will minimise disruptions where possible and safety measures such as fencing will be in place during this work.

All work will take place on weekdays between 7am and 5pm.

Construction vehicles will enter the school via Pound Avenue or Mimosa Street. Traffic control will be used as required for the safety of students, staff and the local community. Please follow the directions of any temporary signage and traffic controllers when in place.

During August and September, some noise disruption may be experienced in the vicinity of the school and neighbouring properties due to the use of contractor tools.
