Davidson High School Works notification | 6 February 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

In October 2024, we shared a <u>Community Update</u> regarding a major hall refurbishment project at Davidson High School.

During the Summer School Holidays, work began on this project.

To ensure the safety of students and staff, construction fencing was installed around the hall.

The hall's level 1 bathrooms and change rooms have been demolished to make way for the new facilities.

This included removing material containing bonded asbestos in the ceilings and toilet partition walls, which were areas listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures were in place while work was done. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

The refurbished level 1 bathrooms and change rooms are scheduled to be finished before the end of Term 1 2025.

When they are finished, work will begin on the main hall upgrade and ground floor bathroom and change room facilities. The project is scheduled for completion mid 2025.
