

# Warrawong High School

## Works notification | 17 February 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

On Thursday 5 February 2026 as part of planned works, replacement of the flooring in the design learning space in Building D at Warrawong High School was being undertaken.

During this work, vinyl tiles suspected to contain bonded asbestos material was found underneath the flooring. Access to the area was already restricted within a construction zone. As a precaution an independent hygienist was engaged to collect fragments for testing and provide advice. Testing confirmed that the fragments contained bonded asbestos. These vinyl tiles are being removed between Saturday 14 February 2026 and Sunday 15 February 2026.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists, who provided a clearance certificate before the room was reopened for use.
