Works notification | 1 May 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are pleased to report that high performance and gifted education (HPGE) upgrades continue at Galston High School.

Under the HPGE program, 33 high schools including Galston High School will receive facility upgrades to accommodate increased enrolments, broaden educational opportunities and facilitate the delivery of tailored HPGE offerings.

Upgrades to the science and music rooms

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

As part of the HPGE program, the science rooms in Building SC and the music rooms in Building SB at Galston High School are currently being upgraded.

As part of these works, known asbestos-containing material was uncovered under the floor tiles in rooms across both buildings. The area is listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan and was already cordoned off with access restricted.

On Friday 17 April 2026, the vinyl floor tiles and glue in Building SC was removed outside of school hours. Work to remove the vinyl floor tiles and glue in Building SB is scheduled to commence on Friday 08 May 2026 and will be completed on Saturday 09 May 2026. Safety measures, including air monitoring, were in place while the work was being done and will be repeated for the upcoming work.

All work done is in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work is being completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist prior to construction restarting.
