Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of regular maintenance, we repaired a classroom window on the first floor of Building EL at Galston High School on 14 January 2025.

Putty used in the window frame is known to contain bonded asbestos, as listed in the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

All work involving asbestos-containing material was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

Following the work, the areas were inspected by an independent hygienist and clearance was provided.

The new glass was installed using silicone sealant.
