Works notification | 12 December 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We replaced the damaged ramp to one of science classrooms at Eden Marine High School.

As part of this work we removed the old ramp, which contains bonded asbestos as per the school's asbestos management plan.

The asbestos was removed on Saturday 29 November 2025. All work involving asbestos-containing materials took place outside of school hours.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures including air monitoring were in place while work was being done. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The area was inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate was issued before refurbishment work continued.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
