## Eden Marine High School Works notification | 23 July 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During planned Winter School Holiday maintenance, asbestos was removed from the staff toilets on level one, Building C at Eden Marine High School.

The school's asbestos register confirmed the presence of bonded asbestos inside the toilet partitions.

NSW Health explains if bonded asbestos is mixed with cement or other hard bonding materials, and in good condition, it is likely to be low-risk.

Air monitoring was installed and the toilets were cordoned off before the partitions were replaced.

All work was done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

All work was completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
