## Chifley College Dunheved Campus Works notification | 11 March 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are upgrading the toilets in Buildings C and E at Chifley College Dunheved Campus.

The work includes removing and replacing the toilet partitions, wall linings and toilet cisterns.

Temporary fencing will be installed to make the areas inaccessible to staff and students during the work. Students can use alternative toilets in Buildings A, J and P.

## Removal of hazardous material

Part of this work involves removing toilet partitions and wall sheeting known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

Any work involving asbestos containing material will take place outside of school hours when staff and students are not on site.

Once the partitions and wall sheets have been removed, an independent hygienist will issue a clearance certificate and the remaining work will continue.

## **Construction work hours**

Work will start on Friday 14 March 2025 and is expected to be finished by the end of Term 2.

Work hours will be Monday to Friday 7 am to 6 pm and Saturday 8 am to 1 pm.
