

# Chifley College Dunheved Campus

## Works notification | 16 February 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Tuesday 3 February, part of the ceiling in the movement area on the ground floor of Building B was damaged at Chifley College Dunheved Campus.

The ceiling is known to contain bonded asbestos and is listed in the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

The movement area in Building B was isolated and made inaccessible to students and staff.

The damaged ceiling was repaired on the same day. While work involving asbestos-containing materials took place within school hours, safety measures were in place during that time. The area was inspected by an independent hygienist and a clearance certificate was issued. The area was reopened on Friday 6 February.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
