## Kanahooka High School Works notification | 18 April 2024

Dear neighbours,

During heavy rainfall in early April, one of the classrooms at Kanahooka High School was damaged. Work to remediate the classroom will involve working with asbestos containing material in the vinyl floor tiles.

The asbestos is bonded to another material such as vinyl or concrete and cannot be crumbled under light pressure.

As a precaution, the classroom has been isolated from students and staff.

Work to remove and replace the vinyl floor tiles will take place from **Monday 22 April – Wednesday 24 April 2024**.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The building will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the rooms are reopened for regular operations.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
