

Willyama High School

Works notification | 19 January 2024

We are working to remediate mould identified at Willyama High School. Due to the severe heat and humidity over the school holidays, mould has developed from moisture inside the school in various locations throughout the school buildings.

The local team are working with an independent occupational hygienist, who has provided advice on remediation.

Starting Monday morning, an approved specialist contractor will begin remediating mould and moisture at the school through environmental cleaning, under the advice of the independent hygienist.

All impacted areas will be environmentally cleaned and air monitoring conducted. Following assessment by the hygienist, each space will be cleared and the school provided with a clearance certificate.

All investigations and remediation are conducted in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations.

We have also assessed key equipment and infrastructure in the school such as the air condition and IT systems to confirm they are in appropriate condition. Some mechanical and minor repairs will also be done as part of the remediation of the school.

We are working closely with Willyama High School leadership to support returning to the school for the start of Term 1 on 8 February 2024, and it is expected all work required will be finished in time for this. Our priority is always to ensure that students can receive face to face learning in a safe environment and are planning alternative arrangements for the start of Term in the unlikely event this is required.

We will keep you updated as work progresses.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
