Works notification | 13 November 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are transforming an art room, kiln room and storerooms into a new flexi-hub at James Meehan High School and this will involve removing vinyl tiles. This work is in Building 1 at the southern end of the campus, near the sports ovals.

These vinyl tiles are known to contain asbestos as per the school's asbestos register.

Work will be taking place Monday 27 November – Saturday 2 December 2023. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

Building 1 will be cordoned off before the work starts, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The building will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated, and the contractor will receive a clearance certificate when complete.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
