Works notification | 29 April 2026

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

As part of routine site maintenance, on Monday 20 April 2026, fragments of material suspected to contain asbestos on the ground were identified by a member of staff at the front of the school, near the bus stop at Muirfield High School.

As a precaution, the area was made out of bounds to students and staff. An independent hygienist was engaged to undertake testing and provide advice.

Test results confirmed the fragments found contained bonded asbestos. The location where the fragment was found was already listed in the school's asbestos management plan.

Work to remove the material and clear the surrounding soil has taken place. The independent hygienist inspected the area and provided clearance for it to be reopened.

Safety measures including fencing, air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment were in place during this work. All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors.
