Works notification | 3 June 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We would like to inform you that we are replacing the carpet in 4 classrooms and the storeroom on Level 1 of Building 5 at Model Farms High School.

The vinyl tiles under the carpet are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

Work to remove asbestos containing materials will take place on Saturday 6 June and Sunday 7 June 2026. All work involving asbestos containing material will take place outside of school hours with safety measures such as PPE and air monitoring in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The rooms will be inspected by an independent hygienist and a clearance certificate will be issued before the rooms are reopened. The new carpet will be installed from Monday 8 June to Wednesday 10 June 2026, with the rooms reopening on Thursday 11 June 2026.
