Works notification | 7 May 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

On Friday 29 April 2026, due to a broken kitchenette water heater, the carpet was flooded and damaged in the storeroom and darkroom space in Building 7 at Model Farms High School.

We will be replacing the carpet in these rooms. As part of this work, vinyl tiles known to contain asbestos as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan, will also be removed. In preparation for this work, the area has been cordoned off with access restricted.

Work to remove the vinyl tiles in the storeroom and darkroom space is scheduled to start from 5 pm on Friday 8 May 2026 and finish on Saturday 9 May 2026. Safety measures, including air monitoring, will be in place while the work is being done.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.
