Works notification | 27 November 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are undertaking maintenance on the boys' toilets in Building E at Moorebank High School.

As part of these works, which include repairing the hinges on the bathroom doors, we will also be replacing partitions in the toilets that contain bonded asbestos as per the school's asbestos management plan.

The asbestos will be removed on Saturday 29 November 2025. All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities. We will keep the community updated.
