Works notification | 03 April 2024

Dear staff and parents/carers,

On 26 March 2024, suspected mould was detected in one sports staff room and one classroom in Building A at Tempe High School.

The rooms have been locked and made inaccessible to students and staff, and we have engaged an independent hygienist to assist with our investigations. As a precaution, students and staff have been relocated to other available classrooms while investigations are underway.

The rooms will remain inaccessible, and students and staff will continue face-to-face learning from their alternative locations until a clearance certificate is received.

All work involving hazardous materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and air monitoring in place while work is being done. All inspections and any remediation works will be conducted in accordance with recommendations from the independent hygienist.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. We will keep the community updated.
