Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of planned maintenance, we are replacing the roofs and louvres on the Science Building (S Block) at Northern Beaches Secondary College Cromer Campus.

Today 3 June 2025, scaffolding will be assembled around S Block and will remain temporarily in place until the works are completed by 20 July 2025. Access to S Block will not be affected. Students and staff can continue to access the building.

The roof replacement involves full removal of the original exterior louvres that are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours, during the winter school holidays while the school grounds are closed.

All work will be in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
