Works notification | 21 June 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are working to remove vinyl tiles in the floor and toilet partitions that are known to contain asbestos material as per the school's asbestos register at Gorokan High School. The vinyl tiles and toilet partitions are located in the:

- staff room in Building A
- girls' and boys' toilets in Building B
- tea rooms in Building D and E

The rooms are being safely used at present as the vinyl tiles are located under the carpet and the toilet partitions are undisturbed. The areas will be cordoned off before the work starts.

Work will take place on Saturday 24 June 2023. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before the work starts.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The rooms will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before they are reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
