Works notification | 22 October 2025

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

During the recent spring holiday period we investigated options for termite remediation in the school hall at Cambridge Park High School.

As part of this work, we removed and disposed of ceiling panels known to contain bonded asbestos in several storerooms in the hall. The ceiling panel material was listed on the school's asbestos management plan and was undisturbed and in good condition.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Safety measures including fencing, air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment were in place during this work. All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

New replacement ceiling panels will be installed once termite remediation is conducted later this year. Termite treatment works will be carried out safely and efficiently to minimise impacts to the school community.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
