Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.5 billion for maintenance and local upgrades.

Blaxland High School's facilities upgrade

As part of this investment, Blaxland High School has received \$1 million to upgrade the existing hall to a specialised school performance space.

Work includes:

- adding a new storeroom and entry lobby
- modifying the performance space including mezzanine floor
- decommissioning, storing (during work) and recommissioning lighting rig and AV equipment
- supplying and installing new retractable seating and separation curtains
- setting, sanding and painting of ceilings that have been installed and re-painting all previous surfaces
- repairing (where needed) and re-application of varnish to timber floors, and relaying dance mats
- supplying and installing new internal glass doors to entry lobby
- · reinstalling of projector
- supply and installing cyclorama screen (a large, curved backdrop used in theatre, film, television, and photography productions).

Work started in January 2025 and is expected to be finished by 31 July 2025.
