School holiday works notification – Winter 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

School holidays are the ideal time to undertake maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning.

Planned work over the upcoming holidays

We are upgrading the volleyball courts in the playground on the south side of Newtown High School of Performing Arts during the winter school holidays.

This period may include from the end of the school day on Friday 3 July up to the first day of Term 3 Tuesday 21 July 2026. Work hours will be between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday.

This project includes resurfacing the existing grassed volleyball court at the back of the oval. The grounds in this area are known to contain bonded asbestos, as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan.

An exclusion zone will be set up around the perimeter of the site while machinery is used for excavation. Vacation care located on the other side of the school in Building C will not be affected by this work and will operate as usual during the holidays.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place with safety measures such as air monitoring in place. All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and will be inspected by an independent hygienist.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
