

# Terrigal High School

## Works notification

**16 June 2021**

Dear parents/carers,

The NSW Government is investing \$60 million to provide roof repairs and replacements to priority schools across rural and regional NSW, including Terrigal High School.

As part of this work a helicopter will be used to lift roof sheeting onto the roof. An exclusion zone will be in place around the perimeter of the school and the school oval will be used for landing and re-fuelling as required. Pedestrian management will be in place around the school perimeter.

Works will be undertaken from 7:30am for approximately 4 hours on two separate days (weather permitting) including:

- Saturday 19 June 2021
- Monday 5 July 2021

The works pose no risk to the local community and will be conducted in accordance with Safe Work NSW requirements. The work is subject to regulatory approval by the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA).

Due to the nature of the work, you may experience increased noise, dust and wind from the helicopter. Please ensure any loose items on your premises are secured.

We will ensure that work is completed safely and efficiently, and disruption is minimised.
