

Lisarow High School

Works notification | 14 October 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On 25 September 2025, a cracked window was reported in the performance classroom in the art building (Building D) at Lisarow High School.

The putty material surrounding the window was undisturbed but assumed to contain bonded asbestos. An independent hygienist was engaged on 30 September 2025 to test the material and provide advice.

Testing confirmed that the window putty contained bonded asbestos. NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

This location is not in an area identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP). The register will be updated to include this recent find as required.

On Saturday 18 October 2025, contractors will remove the putty and replace the glass window under the guidance of an independent hygienist who will issue a clearance certificate when the area can be used.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All works are being completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

Safety measures such as air monitoring and workers wearing personal protective equipment will be in place while work is being done.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
