Works notification | 1 August 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

On Friday 28 July, contractors onsite, attending to a broken toilet door in the boys' toilets in Building M at Lisarow High School, reviewed the recent holiday work conducted in the same toilets.

During the winter school holiday period, maintenance work took place to repair a broken toilet door, which involved installing new door hinges the toilet partition.

The toilet partitions are identified as containing asbestos in the school asbestos register. The boys' toilet has been isolated with air monitoring until licensed and accredited contractors are scheduled to remove the partition.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before the work starts.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The boys' toilet will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before it is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
