Works notification | 1 June 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

On Tuesday 26 May 2026, a damaged partition wall was identified in the student bathroom in Building D at Lisarow High School.

This area is known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan. As a precaution, the area was immediately isolated and an independent hygienist was engaged to conduct air monitoring and provide advice.

All air monitoring to date across the site has returned results below the minimum detectable limit, which means it is consistent with acceptable levels in ambient air (i.e. <0.01 fibres/mL) as per SafeWork NSW guidelines. These results show that there is not a detectable level of asbestos fibres in the air in this area.

Work to replace the partition will take place on Saturday 6 June 2026. The hygienist will return to inspect the area before issuing clearance for it to be reopened.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws. All work will be completed by experienced contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
