

Lisarow High School

Works notification | 30 October 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Wednesday 29 October 2025 a partition was reported to have come off its brackets in the boys toilets in Building D at Lisarow High School.

Material in the toilet partitions in this building is known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos management plan.

NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

The area has been isolated and an independent hygienist has been engaged to conduct air monitoring from Friday 31 October 2025. While the area is cordoned off, alternative toilets are available within the school.

Work to remove and replace the partition has been scheduled for Saturday 15 November 2025.

Safety measures including restricting access, air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment will be in place during this work. All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist with a clearance certificate issued before the area is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
