

# South Sydney High School

## Works notification | 5 June 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We are making improvements at South Sydney High School by upgrading the stormwater and drainage systems to the demountable building next to the hall.

This work will take place on Saturday 13 June 2026 between 11 am and 5 pm.

Construction vehicles will enter the school via O'Sullivan Avenue and park in the restricted construction area.

For the safety of the school community, access to the carpark during this project will be restricted to construction staff.

Community users will not be affected however there may be some low-level noise during these activities. We are committed to minimising disruptions where possible.

### Asbestos removal

The ground in this area is assumed to contain bonded asbestos, as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan, and will need to be remediated before the stormwater upgrade work proceeds.

Work to remediate the grounds will involve:

- digging to the depth of the existing stormwater pipes
- removing and upgrading the pipes
- replacing the soil
- safely removing any surface level asbestos-containing fragments.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will be done with safety measures such as air monitoring and temporary fencing in place. The area will be inspected by an independent hygienist on completion of works.
