Dear staff, parents, and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

Upgrades to stormwater infrastructure

Following the works notification issued in [February 2026](#), stormwater improvements are being planned in an outdoor area near Building L (the Library and Science Block) at South Sydney High School.

As part of these works, we will be removing assumed asbestos-containing material in-ground as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP). As a precaution, the area will be isolated to restrict access to students, staff and school visitors.

The stormwater upgrades will be installed around building L.

Work will begin Saturday 23 May 2026 and we expect the removal of all asbestos containing materials in Building L to be carried out throughout the month of May 2026, weather and site permitting.

Work in the visual art and TAS classrooms

We are replacing the wall and ceiling linings in buildings G and H on the weekends of 16 and 17 May 2026 and 23 and 24 May 2026.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours with safety measures such as in place.

All work is done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures are in place while work is done. All work is completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
