Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of the school community are our highest priorities.

Following recent damage caused by a break-in at Macquarie Fields High School, the NSW Department of Education is undertaking urgent repair and restoration works across multiple rooms in Buildings B, C, D, E, F, G, H and J, as well as several student and staff toilet facilities.

Work is already underway to restore the affected areas and support a return to normal operations as quickly as possible. Further information about the school's operational status and reopening will be communicated directly by the school.

The affected areas have been secured and restricted. During the works, students and staff will be accommodated in alternative locations within the school to minimise disruption to teaching and learning.

For work to take place as quickly as possible, some works may need to occur outside of school hours, including night works. Appropriate safety measures, such as traffic control, signage and temporary fencing may be in place to ensure the safety of the students, staff, residents and workers.

We will continue to keep the school community informed as the works progress.
