Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2025-26 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$9 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

As part of this investment, Tuggerah Lakes Secondary College, Berkeley Vale Campus received a share to improve drainage in the assembly area.

Following on from our <u>November 2024 update</u>, drainage works in the assembly area are on track and will resolve ongoing water leaks and flooding from heavy rain around buildings E, F and G.

These works will ensure there are no disruptions to school operations during periods of heavy rain with the installation of new storm water pipework and storm water pits helping to alleviate pressure on the existing system.

Progress update

Construction on the improved stormwater system has started and is due to be completed early Term 3 2025.

Work hours will be between 7 am and 4 pm Monday to Friday and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday in accordance with NSW Environment Protection Authority construction times.

This work will not affect access to any buildings at the school and the garden areas at the front of buildings E and G will remain fenced off while this work is completed.
