Update on progress to finish new multipurpose hall

SINSW is working hard to prioritise the opening of the NBSC Manly Campus multipurpose hall for the community.

As you are aware, we have encountered significant delays in getting the Building Plan Approval (BPA) from Sydney Water, which is needed to obtain an Occupation Certificate (OC) and allow the hall to be used. Given the facility borders the sewer main, we continue to work with Sydney Water.

SINSW has now submitted a revised report to Sydney Water, which they will review in the coming weeks.

The report includes findings for the water sewer main, and is supported by the original BPA report.

We will update the community as soon as further progress has been made.
