Project overview

A project is underway to build a new multipurpose hall at the Northern Beaches Secondary College Manly Campus. The new hall will provide the students with a place to participate in various sports and fitness activities, hold large gatherings and events and a covered outdoor learning area (COLA) that can be used for outdoor learning or for students to gather during lunch.

New hall ready for use this term

Work on the new multipurpose hall at Northern Beaches Secondary College Manly Campus is almost complete. We have completed landscaping works around the hall and installed a new walkway to improve access for students and staff.

We are finishing internal and external works to furnish, fit out and enable services for use.

We anticipate the hall will be ready for the school community in the coming weeks. We look forward to welcoming school staff, students, and visitors to this new facility.
