Works notification | 23 June 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We are pleased to provide an update following our notice issued on [11 March 2026](#).

Installation of the new pedestrian gate at the school's main entrance and the new vehicle gate across the main driveway on Church Street is now finished and in use at Albion Park High School.

These improvements enhance site security, access management and the safety of students, staff and visitors entering and exiting the school.

Next steps

As part of our school safety improvements, we are in the early stages of planning to secure the rear boundary of the school with fencing. This may include restricting access through the laneway adjoining Scarborough Circuit, which forms part of NSW Department of Education land.

Planning and design for the fencing project are currently underway and we will provide further updates to the school community as more information becomes available.

We appreciate there may be some inconvenience caused by these changes. We understand the importance of maintaining positive relationships with our neighbours and seek to balance that with the safety of and wellbeing of the school and local community.

Keeping our students safe

The department is responsible for managing and maintaining its school sites to ensure they remain safe and secure learning environments for students and staff. School grounds are not intended for public access outside approved school activities and authorised use.

We kindly remind neighbours that entering school grounds without permission or a legitimate reason is not permitted. Restricting unauthorised access helps protect the safety, wellbeing and privacy of students and staff and supports the secure operation of the school.

The NSW Department of Education can fence off school properties as indicated in the [Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901](#) (ILP Act). Albion Park High School is 'inclosed land' for the purposes of the ILP Act.
