

# Erskine Park High School

Works notification | 9 June 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

During routine inspections at Erskine Park High School, a hole was found in a wall of the classroom demountable next to Building AM. The wall is assumed to contain asbestos as per the school's asbestos register.

The area was immediately isolated, and the hole has been taped over.

We are following all the advice and protocols of independent asbestos hygienists and other experts.

Work to remove the damaged wall sheet will take place between Saturday 10 June and Sunday 11 June 2023. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before the work starts.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The classroom demountable will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before it is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
