

Quakers Hill High School

Works notification | 14 March 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Tuesday 11 March 2025 we conducted a routine inspection of areas listed on the Site-Specific Asbestos Management Plan (SSAMP) at Quakers Hill High School.

Small fragments of building material suspected of containing asbestos were found on the grassy area west of Building J. This area is listed on the SSAMP.

The area is not regularly used by students but as a precaution it was made out of bounds after the fragments were found.

We engaged an independent hygienist to remove samples for testing and search the area for further material.

Test results confirmed some fragments contained bonded asbestos. NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

After a thorough inspection, the independent hygienist was satisfied all visible fragments had been removed and issued a clearance certificate on Wednesday 12 March 2025.

The area was reopened and the SSAMP was updated to reflect the new information.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures were in place while work was done.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
